CO-AUTHORS WITH GOD

Yes, God is writing the script for your life.....but not without your input. A good writer is sensitive to the plot, holds captive the meaning of the storyline, and builds to a final chapter that brings things together in a meaningful way. We've all read lots of novels. We just naturally expect that pattern to hold true.

If that's the way we want the storyline of our life to read we have to pay close attention to the narrative we are generating. Do you find yourself apologizing a lot for something you've said that just doesn't "seem like you." Or maybe for something you did that is obviously "out of character." Could you be growing bitter, distant, or angry..... justifying such traits by often saying "that's just not me?" We all must decide and define just who and what we are. If we don't know, it's small wonder that others may become confused. If we have decided that we are Christians then we should be diligent in speaking and doing and living as Christians speak, live, and do. There's no way the story of our lives can end right if the main character is confused about his identity. We absolutely must work together with God to prevent a tragic ending. We work with Him when we read His Word, when we gather here for life-defining worship, when we walk with Him in prayer, when we show compassion, mercy, kindness. Let's all renew our determination to truly "*be who and what we have decided to be.*" ***“Examine yourselves whether ye be in the faith.” II Cor. 13:5 “Prove all things; hold fast to that which is good.” I Thes.5:21***
