THE EASY WAY

If it were easy everyone would do it. Isn't that what we've all heard? You've heard that because it's true. All of us are interested in that "easy way" to some extent. The abundance of "quick fixes" for weight and health issues testifies to that. All over your TV and mine are those endless commercials telling us all that if we'll just invest our money and a few minutes of our time we can all have skinny waists and the cardio of a twenty year old. So we bounce from one easy fix to another. One of the most recent clearly states that if you have a problem with cellulite you're wearing the wrong shoes. Just buy their sneakers and watch that stuff melt away. With doctors telling us it takes exercise and disciplined eating who wouldn't want an easier way?

Do you know why most counseling just doesn't seem to work in fixing troubled marriages? It's because it takes more than "just talking" to fix it. Fixing a hurting relationship requires real work.....and that real work must occur over extended time. For many people that's simply too costly and difficult.

When does a church begin to wither? When that church begins insisting upon the quick fix and easy way. When it confuses some new program for spirituality or substitutes some patented gimmick for real work. Growing a church takes real work, persistent effort, and a dogged determination to be faithful to the Lord in all circumstances. It's a cross-generational commitment that evidences we're in it for the "long haul." ***"Be thou faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of eternal life."***
