REJECTION

The word even sounds ugly, doesn't it? It can take a lot of different forms. You work your hardest and never crack the starting line-up. You apply to a special school and find the rejection letter in the mail. You ask that special person out, and are told no in a less than kind way. You apply for work in ten different places only to find no one that will hire you. You're passed over for a promotion. Your spouse leaves you. Regardless of what form it takes, rejection always has one common result....it hurts! It makes you question yourself. "What's wrong with me?" we ask. Obviously something must be, or I wouldn't be rejected. We've all been rejected at one time or another and in one way or another. How are we to respond? Warren Buffet applied for Harvard Business School at age 19. His rejection letter came in the mail. He refused to become angry, and he refused to grow discouraged. He applied to Columbia and was accepted. "It was there," Mr. Buffet states, "that I met two professors who became my mentors, and through their teaching and influence I am where I am today. Being rejected by Harvard turned out to be one of the best things that ever happened to me."

Rejection hurts our ego. It damages our self-esteem. It dares us to quit trying. None of us are allowed to choose our rejections. Our rejection chooses us. All we can do is determine our response to it. When Joseph was rejected by his brothers he chose to hang in there with God. That was the right choice. When David was rejected by Saul he chose to draw closer to God. As long as we live in this world there will be those that reject us. That's just life, isn't it? We live that life holding fast to this promise. ***"All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out."*** ***John 6:37***
