CHANGE

It's not part of the Genesis account, but I understand from a rather questionable source that Adam's words to Eve as they left Eden were these: "Sweetheart, I perceive we are living through a time of radical change." Okay. Even if one of the original pair didn't say it to the other, it is true nonetheless. In every generation and in the lives of each of us we live through "radical change" Papyrus yields to computer....donkey to jumbo jet....garlic around your neck to penicillin.
