ROUND ROBIN - 2012

A meeting was held a week ago last Saturday involving myself and a representative from each of the nine congregations that are presently participating in our annual Round Robin. These men were tasked by the nine churches to review our organization of the Round Robin and see if there might be a better way of conducting the series of meetings. As you know we have, from the time that we began this several years ago, basically followed the same format. Originally we had five participating churches and simply set a five consecutive night session during the summer months. As the number of churches increased we began holding two separate sessions; one in early June and the other in August. With the number of churches involved it was difficult to avoid conflicts with summer VBS and other activities that are always ongoing. We also noticed that we were having difficulty getting our younger couples with children out due to so many demands on schedules during the summer time. The original purpose of this series of meetings was to deepen the bonds between sister churches in this area, and enable us to get to know one another better. The messages are directed toward encouragement and strengthening of the local church. This purpose still holds true. Out of the Round Robin has come the added fellowship of quarterly men's prayer breakfasts hosted by different churches. We also host quarterly youth activities to help our young folks become better acquainted with one another. As a result of the meeting held on September the 25th a different format for the Round Robin has been set for 2012. We are announcing the dates early so that each of the nine churches can set their local calendar around these dates and not schedule activities that might be in conflict. The format is as follows:

- ◆ Rather than going with two summer sessions of five and four consecutive days as we have been doing we will spread the sessions out through the year.
- ◆ Five of the sessions will be conducted on Sunday evenings of the 5th Sunday of the months. The other four sessions will be conducted on the Wednesday evening immediately following the 5th Sunday session. Sunday evening sessions will begin with singing at 5:30 p.m. with the regular service beginning at 6:00 p.m. Wednesday evening sessions will begin with singing at 6:30 p.m. and the regular service beginning at 7:00 p.m.
- ◆ By choosing the above structure we will obligate our memberships to only days and times in which they would be accustomed to assembling. By being spread out through the year we avoid the extremes of heat in the summer that we have been experiencing. The dates and places are as follows:
