REMEMBER.....HE LIES

From the time of Eden forward, Satan has been telling two vicious lies about God.....and telling them very convincingly. First, he spreads the awful lie that God sets boundaries because He doesn't really love us. He wants to take all the fun out of our lives. He wants to keep things from us that would be really good for us. You remember that strategy, don't you? He convinced Adam and Eve that they would be better off with something God had forbidden. Second, he has had great success in telling the even more awful lie that anyone who crosses one of those boundaries had better be afraid of God. Run from Him as fast as you can and hide. Get away, or get wiped out. This lie is even worse than the first. Yes, the Bible speaks of a reverent fear of the Lord that is the beginning of wisdom. But that is very different from the dread and terrible sense of foreboding from an intolerant, ill-tempered God who is more likely to strike you down than pick you up when you have failed....crossed the line....or really messed up.

Do you remember what happened on that fateful day when God came for an evening stroll with his much loved children in the garden home He had created just for them? Of course you do. They were nowhere to be found. So He called for them, and there was no answer. Then He went looking for them and found them cowering and trying to get out of sight. *"I heard you in the garden, and I was afraid,"* Adam said, *"because I was naked."* Adam had been naked every other evening God had come to visit, and he hadn't been afraid to meet with Him on those days. Neither had Eve. So just what had happened between the last visit and this one? *"Ahh, Larry, they had sinned!"* you say. Very true, but something more had happened. They had been set up for that sin by the devil's first lie and hurt even more by the second. The second one made it much more likely that they wouldn't react well afterward. Satan had somehow convinced them that God was mean, hard, and vengeful. Afraid of God, they looked for a place to hide. And humankind has been running from God ever since....convinced by Satan that the last thing we should do is to run to God when we have failed Him. We sprint away putting as much distance as possible between ourselves and the God we've wronged. Please remember that Satan's advice is always bad. **Don't run from God when you sin....run to Him.**
