REMINDER

The season is upon us. No, not just deer season. Clock changing season. You finally gain back that hour you lost last spring. When you go to bed this Saturday evening be sure all of your clocks have been **set back one hour**. Enjoy that extra hour!

LIFE IS DIFFERENT THERE

You are involved in India Mission work through our ongoing support of the Bible school in Sarapheth. Dayton, along with Washburn, and a few other congregations are the resource God is using to allow this school to exist. The primary goal of the school is to train men to be preachers and elders within local congregations. Women also receive training there. Those who travel there from here have stood before you and tried to give you a glimpse of what life is like over there. None of us are envious of them.

The Church exists there in a culture where race, caste, or gender puts a person in jeopardy from the moment of birth. The problem is so acute in some parts of India that the district of Satara recently took action. In poor, rural areas of India, girls can be considered a family liability. Boys are viewed as potential heirs, family heads, and wage-earners. By contrast, girls are a liability because their families will have to provide a dowry in order to arrange a marriage for them. Boys are so greatly preferred over girls that India made the use of ultrasounds to discover an unborn child's gender illegal. Females were systematically aborted.....or murdered after being born. The Lancet medical journal has published a study that found as many as a half million females in utero are aborted every year in this part of India.

In the Marathi language of this western state many of the girls who were allowed to live have been named "Nakusa." The name means "unwanted." It doesn't fit into our thinking that any parent would do so. Can you imagine life for the child who grows up with that name? The ten year old girl who answers to that name during roll check at school. Will the kids with "real names" taunt her? Could she ever be marriageable to a "respectable" family with the name Unwanted? Does she ever wish to have a daughter and risk the name being carried forward? Thirteen year old Nakusa (Unwanted) Chavin asked her mother, "Why didn't you just kill me when I was born if you didn't want me?" That's the question on the lips of all the girls named "Unwanted" in India.

Yes, life is certainly different here.....and, my, aren't we thankful? It's simply not imaginable to us that our daughters or granddaughters would ever be required to face such a life. And let us remind each other that life is different with God. If anyone dares to label you stupid or worthless hear this good word from God. ***"You shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the Lord will give....You shall no more be called Forsaken, and your land shall no more be termed Desolate, but you shall be called My Delight Is In Her, and your land Married, for the Lord delights in you....and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you."***

Isa.62:2-4 Your new name is a gift from God. Wear it proudly!
