DO YOUR OWN STUDY

Learning takes work and a certain amount of discipline, doesn't it? Ask any of our students here this morning as semester exams are drawing closer. It can be so difficult that many folks simply "opt out". College campuses are filled this weekend with students who should be studying for upcoming finals, but who are instead running around doing everything except studying. Learning a new skill or trade to advance in employment takes work. Many choose to simply remain where they are rather than pay the price that advancement requires. None of us can afford to be intellectually lazy....simply accepting what others tell us is true without any serious examination ourselves. Germany was the most advanced scientific community of the early twentieth century; yet look where their science led them. The nation as a whole really did seek to justify the Holocaust by what they believed to be true. We value the thinking of folks of great intelligence, but folks of great intelligence will often fail to believe what is true or value what is right.

A panel of intelligent economists explain to the rest of us that our nation's huge debt is in reality "good for our county." An Ivy League professor of child psychology reports that casual sexual experimentation is a healthy thing among our teens. An entire faculty of a respected university stands behind a published attack upon faith in a personal God. Surely these folks know what they're talking about. What one "highly intelligent expert" states as undeniably true is parroted by myriads of others who never take the time to investigate the legitimacy of his claims. And so.....off we go.....blind folks following other blind folks until they all end up in the ditch. In the social and economic issues facing our nation let's each "do our own study." In the issues of faith that are before all of us let's be sure to "do our own study." The only infallible One that ever walked this earth was our Lord. Yes, let's each hear others respectfully, but let's always hear with a sense of obligation to examine the position that is being put forth....and to think for ourselves. Think seriously. If that is too much work, or too great a burden, then we must be content to blindly follow where others lead.

Our Lord was very clear on this, wasn't He? *"Every plant which my heavenly Father hath not planted shall be rooted up. Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch."* **Matt. 15:13-14** Paul reminded us of our common responsibility when he said to Timothy, *"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."* **II Timothy 2:15**
