WHAT TO DO WITH FAITH

Sometimes a fella just can't win. As a Christian if you "flaunt your faith" you open yourself up to criticism that all you're doing is "putting on a show." You're immediately judged as a person who just wants to "be seen in order to make some kind of false godly impression." An awful lot of folks know that Jesus taught us not to do anything to "be seen of men, otherwise we have our reward." A strict interpretation of that would require that all of us put our light under the proverbial basket so no one could be aware that we even are Christians. On the other hand if you do not live your faith both publically and privately you are quickly judged as a hypocrite who doesn't "practice what he preaches." I don't know what you think about Tim Tebow. I've always kinda liked him, but he just can't win. And I'm not talking about football. It's his polarizing public image. He "takes the knee" after each touchdown. He thumps his chest and points his finger to the heavens. Now, honestly. Does anyone really think that God cares who wins a football game?

So.....just what is a religious athlete to do? Why doesn't he seem to get any respect? Some of you older baseball fans remember that you never saw Sandy Koufax pitching on a Saturday. Why not? It was the Sabbath. He was a strict Jew. Tim Tebow's faith offends some folks. What would they have him do? Would they prefer he do as so many other professional athletes and violate his convictions and act like a thug? If his religiosity seems a bit "over the top" or immature at times I'd still take him in a heartbeat over the running back that has fathered three children by three different women, and is constantly in and out of rehab. Let's just do this. Let's let Tim Tebow play football. Let's let him live his conservative religious values taught by his missionary parents. The season is over for him. He and Denver were dominated by Tom Brady and the Patriots. Did God decide the outcome of that game? I suspect it was just that Tom Brady and the Patriot defense were too much for him. Let's concern ourselves less with what people think and more with what God says. *"Let your light so shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in Heaven."*
