OUR CHILDREN

They are the source of our greatest joy....and hold the potential for being our greatest sorrow and hurt. Who among us as parents has not lost sleep as we worried about our children. That's why God gave children parents, right? To wring our hands and worry about them. The particular type of worry changes as they grow older, but the worry can be there regardless of age. When they are younger they tend to be conscious only of the immediate....the next meal, tonight's ballgame, braces, bad hair, pimples, girl(boy) friends. They are constantly puzzled by life. They often don't know what to think about a variety of things, including their parents. They become angry with siblings, and search for their own space in a family that often seems crowded to them. Our children who once couldn't wait to get to church, go to Bible class, and rummage through some ladies purse for gum, now have to be pried out of bed with a crow bar on a Sunday morning.

Often the best any of us can do is worry....and pray. Then worry and pray some more. It doesn't stop when they leave home. Often it intensifies as they use their new found freedom to explore things that they never would have been allowed under mom and dad's roof. As our children grow older the worst thing we can do is to try to force things to the conclusion that we want as parents. Friends, neighbors, and our own children have this terrifying thing called "*freedom*." And freedom is that double-edged sword that has the possibility to accept or reject.

Just what are we to do as parents? Let's all continue to love, believe in, and pray for our children....regardless of age. We have all invested more than time and money in our children. Heart, soul, and ceaseless prayer is also invested. As long as we have breath to breathe as parents, we will continue to hope for the best for our children. If they have strayed we will become the "father of the prodigal" who never gave up waiting for his son to come home.
