THE JOB IS MINE

Have you ever seen an elderly person in Walmart looking confused and lost....or maybe a small child alone and bewildered and thought...."there ought to be an employee helping them?" Have you ever listened to a troubled friend and wished there was a professional counselor available to help? Have you seen a neighbor's life spiral out of control and wished your preacher could share a fresh perspective with them? The truth is there aren't enough Walmart employees to help the aged or young in their distress.....there aren't enough professional counselors to match with all the folks in pain over troubling circumstances.....there aren't enough preachers to go around for all the people who are struggling spiritually. So....what should we do?

Simply accept the fact that when we encounter struggling folks and wonder why someone doesn't help that the "*job is mine to help*." Where did we get the idea that it takes a professional credential of some kind to help people who need help. Surely we remember that it was professionals who built the Titanic...which sank...while it was amateurs who built the Ark...which floated and saved the world. Somehow in the year of 2012 professionalism in America we have convinced ourselves that only a certain few are qualified to help. The idea of leaving God's work in the hands of a talented few just isn't Biblical or practical. Such a notion turns into a Sunday performance done by the few for the critique of the many. What happened to the Bible concept of every believer being a priest? That all of us are called of God and qualified by God to help each other. I know what the American concept of "ordained clergy" is, but I'm not so sure you can find either the term or the concept in your Bible. Yes, the Bible does speak of people with special gifts and ministries, but **Eph. 4:12** tells us that their job is to "*equip all of us to be helpers*" of those around us. God certainly needs preachers and elders and deacons and teachers. But if the world needs help...and it does...it's going to take all of us to do it. The growth and nurturing of the Dayton Church isn't the job of just a few. It's my job. It's your job. All of us individually, and all of us collectively. Let's get to work.
