AND HOW DO WE SOUND?

I really like watching Antiques Roadshow. If I am where I can when 6:00 p.m. rolls around on Saturday evening I'll be watching the PBS channel. And it's not just to see someone discover that they have an incredibly valuable object. I just like seeing their old treasures. Last week a lady had two pots.....both ceramic. Those were made by someone who took the clay and molded it into the proper shape. The pieces were then placed in a really hot oven (call it a kiln and heat it to 1,200 degrees Celsius). Those pots were left in that heat for fourteen hours, and then allowed to cool for a day. The heat of that kiln transforms the clay into glass and metal particles that interlock to form the fine porcelain that is both strong and hard so it becomes resistant to penetration by chemicals that would weaken or discolor it. The last step is for the artist to color and glaze it to bring out the brilliant and lasting color.

But the woman brought two pots. The roadshow expert asked the lady, "Do you know how to distinguish high quality porcelain from the inferior stuff?" She did not. The expert said, "listen," and then put one pot in her palm and took her finger and gave it a solid thump. A beautiful and distinctive "ring" came from the large bowl. It was really valuable. The second bowl looked mighty good to me, but what do I know? The expert thumped the second bowl and it sounded like someone thumping an overripe watermelon. The second bowl was flawed. One bowl very valuable....the other not....all determined by the "ring" when thumped.

That made me wonder about me. We all get thumped from time to time, and that thumping reveals the stuff we are made of. All of us are formed by life's experiences....by both pleasant and unpleasant days. Crisis moments place us in the heat of fire, and we emerge refined and matured....or embittered, flawed, and brittle. *"Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow."* **James 1:2-3** I don't know what this week will bring for any of us, but if it gives us a thumping, let's let our hearts ring true!
