PULL UP THAT ANCHOR

You could put everything I know about boats on the head of a pin and still have room for an encyclopedia. The only boat I've ever had any real experience with is a little two seater that's tied to the dock at the back of our house. About the only thing I do know is that you're not going anywhere if you don't pull up the anchor. Trying to row a boat while dragging that dead weight becomes an exercise in futility. We often find ourselves anchored to our own personal history. What we think about God, about others, about our own self worth, about right and wrong, about life itself is often dictated by our past. The kind of people our parents were, the kind of experiences we have as adults, the hurts, the disappointments, the betrayals can grab hold of us and keep us from moving forward. Breaking free of our past is a daunting task for many. We so easily slip back into old habits, attitudes, and dispositions. God is calling us to journey with Him. Answering that call requires faith and courage. Actually believing God when He tells us there are some things we must let go of if we are ever to make the journey, and being brave enough to actually let them go. Cut loose the dead weight. Somebody smarter than me first said, "*Your past may explain you....it does not lock you in.*" ***"Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin that doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us; looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith..." Hebrews 1:1-2***
