When Jack and Betty Reynolds moved to this community more than thirty years ago Betty was the first to visit this church. Betty had been raised a devout Catholic, and wasn't very well acquainted with things in the Church of Christ world, but she listened, and read her Bible. Jack didn't come with her, and Betty said she didn't think he ever would. Betty kept coming, and on July 27, 1980, I was privileged to baptize her into Christ. Our Lord added her to the Church. Betty has been a solid fixture here since that time. Betty was wrong about Jack. He did come. He likewise listened, and read his Bible. On September 21, 1980, I was privileged to baptize Jack. They plunged headlong into the life of this church. Jack eventually became a deacon here, and set a high standard of work. Jack began serving as our treasurer making sure bills were paid and deposits made. When Jack died in October of 2000 Betty stepped in to handle the bookkeeping. She has continued to do so for the last dozen years. She took us from pencil and paper bookkeeping to using computer software programs to keep up with the increasing work. Unfortunately, the time for her work in this area has come to a close. Betty wrestles with very real health issues that would put most of us in bed whining about how cruel life is....but not her. We all thank God for Betty and her presence among us each day. She always has been and will continue to be a tremendous encouragement to me personally.

Her place as bookkeeper needs to be filled. We will be looking for someone who has enough computer background and software experience to be comfortable stepping into the work. Primary responsibilities are as follows:

-Filing paperwork
-Paying monthly bills
-Making weekly deposits
-Reconciling bank statements
-Maintaining records of individual contributions for tax deduction purposes
-And working with Charlie Young who is our deacon serving as treasurer for this church.

This is a part-time position. We would like to make a decision about this as soon as possible. At present I am paying the bills and making deposits, but my skill level and own health issues won't allow for this for very long. Some of you have expressed an interest in time past. ***Any of you who might be interested please let Joe Bridges know.*** We would like to do the interviews in a couple of weeks. We anticipate that several will express an interest. We can only select one which means someone(s) may be disappointed. That in itself always makes these kind of decisions difficult. Again, thank you, Betty, for your years of faithful service to this church.
