BEING or FEELING SPIRITUAL....WHICH?

Just what really is “*spirituality?*” Ask a variety of people, and you’ll get a variety of answers. Most of the folks that we associate with every day are interested in spirituality just as we. We attend church somewhere every now and then, or perhaps even regularly. We know some things that are taught in the Bible, and those things often influence our decisions. We tend to divide life and its activities between the spiritual and the secular, and we distinguish between the two on the basis of how those activities make us “*feel.*” When we involve ourselves in worship, in prayer, in Bible reading, we feel more spiritual. When we withdraw from the demands of this world on our lives and attend a retreat filled with focus on God and our relationship with Him, we certainly feel more spiritual. We dive headlong into the “hustle and bustle” of earning a living and raising our kids with all of the demands on time that the raising requires. We struggle to find and maintain a block of time each day where we can step back....withdraw from the demands....and “find that feeling” that we associate with true spirituality.

May I just remind us that true spirituality is more than a feeling. It is a spiritual relationship that we share with our Spiritual Creator....and that relationship is deeper and stronger than “*human feeling.*” It is reflected, not just in what the world would define as spiritual activities, but in the mundane ones as well. Do you remember what Paul said? “*If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.*” **I Corinthians 14:37** Spirituality recognizes at its foundation the relevance of the Word of God in every aspect of our lives. That word certainly directs our worship and our quiet times, but it just as certainly directs our time at work for our employer, and the relationship that we enjoy with our family. The ordinary and routine things of our daily lives in this very busy world are as much a part of our spirituality as our time at worship. Let me give you this passage in the KJ version. “*I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.*” **Romans 12:1** Now, the same verse in the MSG (Message Version). “*So here’s what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life....your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking around life....and place it before God as an offering.*”

Spirituality is simply living life....living it according to God’s Word....living it as a conscious decision to honor Him in whatever activity is before you at the moment. It’s keeping your focus on Him even when, or maybe especially when, your “*feelings*” are not as up-to-par as you would have them to be. John reminded all of us, “*For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.*” **I John 3:20**
