## SPRING?

It's funny the way the weather changes so quickly around here. Last week, I talked about how nice a day it had been, only to have most of you reading what I talked about on a wet and dreary Sunday. I wrote what was going in the bulletin the Friday before—one of the prettiest days we'd had in awhile. I drove home from work with the windows down and the music turned up (probably a lot louder than I should have.) But then, practically overnight, the bitter cold returned and the rain came down once again. We know our God is mighty and powerful. We also know that the weather is subject to His command. In **Genesis 7:4** we hear this stated to Noah. *"Seven days from now I will send rain on the earth for forty days and forty nights, and I will wipe from the face of the earth every living creature I have made."* We talk about downpours, but I'm pretty sure those pale in comparison to what Noah witnessed. We know Jonah experienced His expertise in meteorology as well, as told to us in **Jonah 1:4**. *"Then the Lord sent a great wind on the sea, and such a violent storm arose that the ship threatened to break up."* Now, I haven't seen any kind of weather on the scale of what Noah and Jonah witnessed, but I've seen a few things. I distinctly remember being hid in the bathroom of our home when I was a child as a storm went over. When all was said and done, our back porch had become part of our front yard. Now, the folks that get paid to look at that kind of stuff said it was only "straight line winds" and not a tornado, but I don't think they came and saw our front porch. Fast forward a few years, and we were in Florida when a Tropical Storm came ashore. I figured out that day why a lot of Florida's traffic lights are hung up sideways. Some of you may recall when I went to Mexico a few years ago. While we were there, a moderate earthquake (I think they said it was a 6.8) shook us up a bit. These are a few of the more extreme weather situations, but we know that God's creation is around us everyday. Whether it's sunny and warm, hot and dry, cold and damp, or any combination thereof—we know that God is in control. There used to be a billboard up in Fort Smith—it had a weatherman pointing up to the sky and it said "So-and-so (I've forgotten his name) said it would be like this." I'm pretty sure even he missed one every now and then, so it wasn't entirely accurate. I think it would be neat to see another form of this billboard. "God made it just like this." Just like the weather, whether it's "sunny" or "rainy" in our everyday lives, we can be assured that God is in control. Remember **Psalms 107:28-30**—*"Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and he brought them out of their distress. He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed. They were glad when it grew calm, and he guided them to their desired haven."*
