EASTER

It really is about more than real dyed eggs or artificial plastic ones. It's more than Walmart Easter baskets with colored grass. It's more than massive public egg hunts or the private backyard kind. There was a time when you could always count on getting something new to wear to church on Easter Sunday, but that time seems to be slipping away from us as the attire for church is becoming increasingly casual. Whatever customs you still hold on to regarding Easter I am sure you understand that they are just customs. *"On the third day Jesus rose from the dead."* The actual date is unknown. We just know it was three days after he died. Yes, we do know He died the Friday before the Jewish Passover and rose the Sunday following. It's just that over the last two thousand years with calendar changes we have trouble pin pointing the exact date. That's OK. Because we do know this one thing with absolute certainty. *"On the third day Jesus rose from the dead."* The truth of that isn't based upon any custom. It's true Biblically. It's true historically. It's true eternally. And the truth of that changed the world all those centuries ago, and is still changing the world today. All of us here this morning would not be here this morning if it were not for that truth. We don't know just where we would be, but we do know that wherever it was we would be there without hope.... with nothing to look forward to except an open grave. So on this date of March 31 we do what we have always done....from the time that we first embraced the truth of His empty tomb. We rejoice. We celebrate the victory of life over death....of hope over despair....of good over evil. When the women came to the tomb that Sunday they worried about who would roll the stone away. They needn't have. An angel came. *"He rolled back the stone and then sat on it. Shafts of lightning blazed from him. His garments shimmered snow white. The guards at the tomb were scared to death. They were so frightened, they couldn't move. The angel spoke to the women. 'There is nothing to fear here. I know you're looking for Jesus, the One they nailed to the cross. He is not here. He was raised, just as He said. Come and look at the place where He was placed. Now go on your way quickly and tell His disciples He is risen from the dead.'* The women, deep in wonder and full of joy, lost no time in doing just that." **Matthew 28:3-8** We, like they, are deep in wonder and full of joy!
