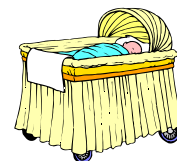

HOLINESS.... Peter told us about it, and our Lord showed us what it looked like in human flesh. Peter quoted God when he wrote in I Peter 1 God's own words. Here's what He said, *"Be ye holy, for I am holy."* But what are we to be when we are being that? Just what does holiness look like? It is true that holy people are separated from the dark, ugly, and evil things in this world. One aspect of holiness involves a lack of activity in those type of things. But you've read your Bible. You know that true holiness is a lot more than refusing to participate in those things. Jesus shows us that true holiness is fully involved in life. Our Lord didn't live His life in a mountain retreat. He jumped into this world with both feet. He lived out His holiness among people in such a way that people were made better. People were amazed by Him....by His teaching and by His life. While he never involved Himself in the ugliness of sin, He fully involved Himself with sinners. Holiness isn't just a rigid and inflexible list of things we "don't do." It's even more so the endless things we choose to do in helping others to get a better picture of God. It's less about what scared people avoid than what saved people pursue. God calls us to holiness, and that call is a challenge to make this world a better place. *"So roll up your sleeves, put your mind in gear, be totally ready to receive the gift that's coming when Jesus arrives. Don't lazily slip back into those old grooves of evil, doing just what you feel like doing. You didn't know any better then; you do now. As obedient children, let yourselves be pulled into a way of life shaped by God's life, a life energetic and **blazing with holiness.**"* **I Peter 1:13-16** (Message Version) The challenge Paul gave all of us is worded this way. *"Put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and **true holiness.**"* **Ephesians 4:24**
