Our next monthly elders, deacons, and men's **business meeting** will be held on Sunday evening. May 12, beginning at 5:00 p.m. downstairs.

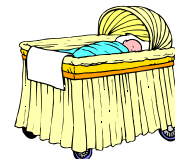

BUSINESS MEETING DECISIONS

In our regular monthly business meeting held last Sunday evening the following things were discussed and decisions made:

- ◆ Due to an upcoming increase in cost we will **no longer subscribe** to the *Gospel Minutes* publication. Less than half of the publications are being picked up, and it was determined that the money could better be used against the church loan.
- ◆ After discussion the decision was made not to conduct our usual **summer VBS** for this year. Those who have been leading in this are needing a break. We will be reviewing this decision prior to next summer, and also looking at other alternatives to how we normally conduct our VBS.
- ◆ We will be recognizing our six **graduating high school seniors** on Sunday evening, May 26. Graduates and families, please mark this date on your calendar.
- ◆ Due to growing need we will be adding more **handicap parking spaces** to the present number. These will be added along the front and East side of the building.
- ◆ We have for many years dedicated our **5th Sunday contribution** to Southern Christian Home. In lieu of that we are increasing our monthly support to the Home from \$120 per month to \$500. In the future we will be setting aside the 5th Sunday contribution to the early payment of our church loan. None of us like paying interest charges. Paying the loan off as early as possible will enable us to put that money to better use.
