**ANGER...OR LOVE?**

Yes, I know basketball season is over, but I ran across an article recently that carried me back a few weeks. Just a couple of months ago we were talking about the sweet sixteen, the elite eight, the final four, and then the big show that determined the NCAA National Champions. I watched a lot of basketball during that time....and enjoyed it. Strange as it may seem, I can't at the moment remember who won. Maybe it's age, or maybe it's just that the game is more than who wins or loses. I did not see the game when the South Dakota State Jackrabbits played. I wish I had. Having never seen their coach, Scott Nagy, I like him a lot. I like it that he and his wife adopted an orphan child from Haiti and invest time, influence, and money in seeing that the other children in the orphanage have shoes and clothes. His theme for his well coached team is *"Play like you're loved."* His explanation of the theme in an interview stated, *"We don't run around like we're in a lovey-dovey commune. But what I want our guys to know is that family, teammates, and coaches love them, and that your performance whether good or less than good doesn't change that."* I don't know if that's a good coaching technique or not, but I like it. I like it a lot better than the better known team from a really big school that took the court all year to the theme *"Play Angry."* That theme was emblazoned on "T" shirts and chanted by thousands of fans in the stands.

As Christians which banner do we hoist? Under which flag do we march forth? I understand that anger is a motivator. It stirs folks to frenzied activity. I've heard some preaching that seemed to be done under the *"play angry"* theme. To some the church exists to proclaim the wrath of God. Churches march, protest, fill the streets, and shout out their anger at all the sins and failures of mankind. The problem with angry people is that they tend to be brittle and jittery. The folks around them tend to feel their anger as mean-spirited judgment. Do you know any Christian that was driven away from the church by some well meaning brother or sister who marched under the banner of *"play angry?"* Do we have enough of a handle on grace yet to understand that it is not *"performance based?"* If you are like me some days you do a better job of living than other days. Some times we perform like a professional....other times like a rank amateur. Folks, let me remind us all that we are not challenged of God to earn His love this week. Our challenge is to believe it....accept it....rejoice in it. Our challenge is to march forth under His banner of love....living with an assurance of forgiveness and acceptance. Our challenge is to simply live as people *"who know that we are loved."* These are Paul's words. *"I ask Him that with both feet planted firmly on love, you'll be able to take in with all followers of Jesus the extravagant dimensions of Christ's love. Reach out and experience the breadth! Test its length! Plumb the depths! Rise to the heights! Live full lives, full in the fullness of God."* **Ephesians 3:18-19** John writes, *"This is the kind of love that we are talking about...not that we once upon a time loved God, but that He loved us and sent His son to clear away our sins and the damage they have done to our relationship with God."* **1 John 4:9-10**
