ARE YOU ASKING QUESTIONS?

Maybe you should stop....or maybe not....depends on the question if I am reading my Bible correctly. *"Stay away from mindless, pointless questioning over genealogies and fine print in the law code. Such gets you nowhere."*

Titus 3:9 The enemies of our Lord believed themselves to be smarter than this carpenter from Nazareth. At the beginning of His ministry they bombarded Him with questions they felt sure He could not answer. Before His ministry was over they learned to quit asking. *"That stumped them, literalists that they were. Unwilling to risk losing face again in one of the public verbal exchanges they quit asking Him questions for good."* **Matt.22:46**

We have all hung around children long enough to appreciate how naturally inquisitive they are. They are just little "question sacks" who want to know about everything....so they ask about everything. *"What makes it rain?" "How does Superman do that?" "Why did my cat have to die?" "Why is red not yellow?"* And the eternal favorite from the back seat of the car: *"Are we there yet?"* Our grandson, Landon, is two years old, and verbal to the extreme. He was reciting the birthday months of some of his favorite people. You ask him when Papaw was born, and he'll tell you *"August."* I asked him last week when he was born, and his quick reply was *"November."* And then without a pause he asked me, *"If there is a November, is there a YESvember?"* A two year old mind goes places a 65 year old mind has never been. Kids have questions, no doubt about it. They have so many questions that some days just one more will get on your last nerve. One thing is certain, it is never boring when bright and inquiring children are hanging around.

Life around some of us adults, however, can be very boring. Some never ask questions. They've forgotten how. They hold to the same dull routine, questioning nothing, and rocking no boats. When we stop asking questions we betray our complacency, settle for mediocrity, and stop learning. People who are intellectually dead fear the person who asks questions. The questioner disturbs our mental slumber. Questions scare us because we often have so few workable answers. The answers we do have are often to questions that nobody is asking any more. I have grown to appreciate your willingness to ask questions around this place. In Bible class your questions lead us places that we otherwise might never have gone. You ask them.....not like the leaders of Jesus' day who were always looking for a good fight....but because you understand there are things you do not know, and you have a naturally inquisitive mind. The search for truth can only be conducted by inquiring minds that are not afraid to ask the right questions....and to ask them of the right source. Jesus said, *"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man cometh to the Father but by me."* **John 14:6** Let's continue to search His Word for the answers to the questions that impact upon eternity. And let's continue to trust the credibility of the One who provides those answers.
