IT'S IN THE BIBLE

Or is it? You've all heard the following: "Everything happens for a reason." "Out of the mouths of babes..." "Money is the root of all evil." "Sow the wind; reap the whirlwind." "To err is human; to forgive is divine." "All men are created equal." You've been raised in the Bible belt of America, and with that raising are able to quickly pick out the Biblical from the non-Biblical. Most folks can't do what you can do. For them, if it sounds like something that might be in the Bible then it probably is. Of those above statements you know that only two of them are from the Bible. The second (***Psalm 8:2***) and the fourth (***Hosea 8:7***) are found in Scripture. The third one fools some folks because it's close to what Paul said, but you know that he stated it is the "*love of money*" that is the root of all evil. Most folks do equally poor with the following: "Jesus loves me this I know." "God moves in mysterious ways His wonders to perform." "A penny saved is a penny earned." "An idle mind is the devil's workshop." Of those four famous sayings none are found in your Bible or mine.

Politicians, motivational speakers, and some coaches are notorious for taking some well-known saying and as-signing it to the Bible. They're not sure where it came from, but it sounds Biblical, and they figure their audience doesn't know any better anyway. Preachers can be just as guilty as anyone else. It's not that we mis-quote the source of the saying so much as we take a truly Biblical concept and give it a non-Biblical meaning or emphasis. It's called "taking things out of context," or "arranging Scripture to support an unscriptural position." We sometimes decide what we want to believe about a given subject, and then go in search of Scripture to support our pre-determined position, rather than "searching the Scripture with an open mind" to let the Scripture determine our position. Those guys in Berea that Paul preached to "*received the Word with all readiness of mind and searched the Scriptures daily to see whether those things were so.*" ***Acts 17:11*** When we pick up our Bible each day for reading and meditation we're not searching for pithy quotes that we can use to impress folks with our wisdom. We're searching the mind of God for the kind of people He would have us to be. This world is full of quotes reflecting human wisdom. We're looking for something more....something living....something eternal....***the truth of the Word of God.***
