I don't go to the movies much anymore because I can't understand the dialogue. It might as well be in a foreign language. I do buy DVDs of those I would like to see. I can put the closed caps on those things and read what is said. So....I bought the movie "42" about the life of Jackie Robinson. I knew as soon as it came out that I wanted to see it. Evidently a lot of other people did as well because in its first weekend it took in \$27.3 million, and was the box-office leader. I love the story, and I loved the movie. For any of you who might not know, Jackie Robinson was the first black player in an all white professional baseball league. He changed the game forever, and made millions of people who care nothing at all about baseball rethink some of their prejudices. But....there was something missing from the movie....left out not by mistake or because it would make the movie too long. Hollywood just didn't want it in there. What was left out was the one thing that was central to his ability to handle the abuse and the threats that came his way....it was his faith. He often and clearly attributed his ability to deal with physical and verbal abuse that came his way to his faith in God. His mother taught her children that God loved them. *"I never stopped believing that,"* Jackie said. There were some difficult times in his growing up without a father....fights....minor scrapes with the law. But all of that stopped when a minister named Kari Downs entered his life. Jackie began his custom then of praying by his bed each night. The movie portrayed his signing with the Brooklyn Dodgers by General Manager Branch Rickey. What it did not portray was Rickey's faith. Branch Rickey called himself a *'Bible thumping Methodist.'* The movie doesn't show the first meeting between Rickey and Robinson. Rickey pulled out a book on his desk titled *The Life of Christ*. He read Jesus' passage from the Sermon on the Mount about turning the other cheek, and asked Jackie to read a section from the book about nonresistance to the provoking of evil. At that very first meeting those two men made a covenant with each other that in the turmoil and abuse that would certainly come they would follow the teaching of Jesus....and they did....and doing so changed the world of baseball forever. More importantly, it changed the thinking of millions of people.

We probably ought to be used to it by now. Hollywood has absolutely no interest in featuring anything positive about the faith that sustains and empowers us as Christians. Why should that surprise us? God hasn't called Hollywood to preach the Gospel. That's not their commission....it's ours. Let's proclaim it. It still conquers the evil of prejudice. It still changes lives. It still saves souls from bitterness, hatred, and violence. Paul spoke for us all when he said, *"For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ for it is the power of God to salvation to all those that believe."* **Romans 1:16**
