REALLY LISTENING

Have you heard the story about the psychiatrist, engineer, and doctor who got lost in the Canadian woods? Stumbling on a trapper's cabin but getting no response to their knock on the door, they went inside to find shelter and wait for his return. In the corner, on a crude platform at waist-high level, was a wood burning stove. It quickly became not only the focus of interest for their half-frozen bodies, but the center of their conversation as well. The psychiatrist explained the stove's unusual position as evidence of psychological problems brought on by extreme isolation. The engineer, on the other hand, saw it as an ingenious form of forced-air heating. The physician's best guess was that the poor guy had arthritis and found it too painful to bend over to fuel his stove. They all defended their positions on the reason for the "high stove" with rigor and great confidence. When the trapper finally walked in the door, after brief introductions, they immediately asked about the unusual placement of the stove and the reason for it. "It's simple," the trapper said. "My stove pipe was too short."

It's really difficult to read someone's mind, is it not? We often take a look at things going on in someone's life and conclude we know all about it. We speak about "walking a mile in the other person's shoes," but at some level understand that such is never really possible. To really understand others we have to learn to listen....really listen. The same is true regarding understanding God. You have to watch out for guys like me who may tell you we know all about what God is thinking....about His reasons....about His purposes. We debate each other regarding such things like the three uninvited guests debated placement of the stove. The truth is none of us has exclusive knowledge of God. Isaiah told us long ago that "*our thoughts are not His thoughts, and our ways are not His ways.*" That being the case then whatever I know of God that is true I know because He has told us. If I am to ever come to know God I absolutely must learn to listen....really listen when He speaks. When He speaks of Himself through his creation I must listen....really listen. And when He speaks through His Word I must set aside all pre-conceived notions drawn out from the well of human intellect, and listen....really listen....to what He tells us of Himself. Ten times in your Bible and mine Jesus asked the equivalent of this question. "*Having ears, hear ye not?*" **Mark 8:18** Just like you, I've got two of them. Let's use them to listen to each other..... to listen to God.
