PEER PRESSURE.....GOES BOTH WAYS

As much as you hear about peer pressure these days you would think the phrase was somewhere in the Bible. It's not....but several synonyms for it are. In the King James Version probably the word you bump into the most is fellowship. I am told fellowship is translated from three Greek words: *Koinonia*...a sharing in common, *Metosche*...a partnership, and *Koinonos*...denoting a partaker. Parents and school folks constantly caution kids about choosing their friends and associates wisely. When a son or daughter tries to step outside the bounds of acceptable dress or behavior, and the parent corrects them, the phrase that has been heard by practically every parent on the planet is, "*but Mom, everybody's doing it.*" Mom's typical response is the age old question, "*So, if everybody was jumping off a bridge, would you do that too?*" If you didn't hear that question from your mom at some point in your choice of wardrobe, vocabulary, lifestyle, refusal to shower, distaste for school, curfew time, or a dozen other things it might mean you didn't have a mother who cared much about the immature things kids tend to do. The Biblical admonition is found in ***I Corinthians 15:33*** where Paul says, "*Don't fool yourselves....bad company ruins good manners.*" We've all seen it happen. A perfectly good kid, or a reasonably responsible adult, begins to act in ways other than what is usually seen. A parent begins immediately to check the behavior and reputation of the friends....a wife or husband begin to observe the lives of associates. A good person can go bad. Life has shown us that over and over. But you also know that a bad person can go good. Change the environment. Step away from old friends and surround yourself with new and better ones. We've all seen that work as well.

Peer pressure is neither good nor bad. It is simply a reality in life. In America we tend to extol what is called "*rugged individualism.*" All that means is one individual standing against the tide of evil and corruption. One person determined to make a difference by resisting the predominant way of thinking about truth and goodness. But if you back us into a corner most of us would have to confess we are not very good at rugged individualism. We do much better when we surround ourselves with others who value the things that we value. God commands us to "*come out from among them and be separate*" from the world that has been corrupted by evil. But when God denies us the fellowship of the world He purposely brings us into a much greater fellowship. The Bible calls it the *Church*. We encourage our young people when headed off to college to become involved with the campus church youth group. We understand that as they leave our homes it becomes vital that they surround themselves with the right kind of "*peer pressure.*" The reality is that it is every bit as vital for we who are their parents to surround ourselves with that same kind of influence. This church in this community serves that function. The literal translation of the Bible word "church" is the "*called out.*" We are the folks that have been called out of one thing and called into another. The elders of the Dayton Church proclaim the essential nature of this church. You aren't just another number on the board in the foyer. You are one of the people here who need all of the other people here to assist us all in this journey to Heaven. The way really is fraught with danger. There really are many pitfalls. I need your help....and you need mine if this journey is to be successful. Let's all help each other. We are all better people because of the fellowship that we share in this place. Don't deny yourself that, but rather immerse yourself in it.
