DAVION NAVAR HENRY ONLY

That's his name. Only one of the four names is heard very frequently here in South Sebastian County, Arkansas. If you watch ABC news you heard his story a few weeks ago. I heard the broadcast segment about Davion, and then found out a little more over the internet. He is fifteen years old, and has had some weight problems. He has also become known for a rather volatile temper. He is bright, but as many bright kids has had rather poor academic performance. His report card never reflected his intelligence. Unlike any of us, Davion was born in prison and removed from his birth mother. His mother was a drug addict and convicted felon. His life has been spent in the foster care system of Florida, and he has been hoping for one thing as long as he can remember. That one thing is what he calls his "forever family."

This last summer Davion determined that he was going to try to find the birth mother he had never known. He used a library computer and data from his birth certificate to search for her. He found her mug shot from her conviction for theft and drug use. He also found her obituary. She had died only a few days before at the age of fifty-five. He remembers thinking, "This is ridiculous. How could I not know?" With the help of his caseworker he went to her funeral and met several of the members of her family and his. None of them were in a position to offer him a home, but several of them told him how happy they were to meet him. They told him they cared about his welfare and wished for him a better life than his mother had. He got in the car and told his caseworker, "I didn't know I was loved by anyone." That realization moved him to change. He lost forty pounds. His grades moved into the mostly A's category. He began some serious work on his anger issues. Then this last September he stood in front of his church and said, "I want a forever family that will love me til I die." According to a later interview with Davion this is what happened: *Without looking up, Davion wiped his palms on his pants, cleared his throat, and said: "My name is Davion, and I've been in foster care since I was born....I know that God hasn't given up on me. So I'm not giving up either."* Later, in a TV interview, he pleaded, "If you can, please reach out and get me...and love me til I die." According to ABC news there had been some 5,000 phone requests and another 5,000 e-mail inquiries about adopting him. A spokesman for the Florida's Department of Children and Families says, "We're hopeful and fully expect that we can connect Davion with his forever family." His story was shared in order to draw attention to the more than 400,000 children who are in foster care across the United States, and who also wish for a real "forever home."

Some of you have served and are serving as foster parents. Some of you have made your home a "forever home" for precious adoptive children. May God continue to bless you. All of you have served to support such efforts by your contribution faithfully given each week. Southern Christian Home and Paragould Children's Home are among those that are supported each month by you.
