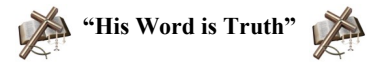
THE SUPER BOWL.....AGAIN

For years I had to be content with next day highlights or rushing home to just see the end of the game. Then came the video recorder. What a great thing. VHS tape could capture six hours worth of activity. (Unless, again like me, you set the machine up wrong or came home only to find the machine had eaten your tape.) I no longer worry about when the game is on. The latest digital recording equipment is trustworthy, and you can just pretend you're watching it live. I've never figured out why they use Roman Numerals, have you? I think it's just another plot to make guys like me feel ignorant. I can handle the numbers up to XXX, but anything beyond that is problematical. Next Sunday it will be Super Bowl XLVIII. I have no idea what number that is. I could look it up, but, to be honest, laziness gets in the way of a lot of things I could do. So.....It's Seattle and Denver, in case you didn't know, but wanted to. I vote for Denver. I like Peyton Manning, and not just because he's a great football player.

Unlike the ranting, screaming, out-of-control, chest thumping Seattle Seahawk yelling at the camera after the playoff game, Peyton Manning is simply a class act. He's polite. He directs the attention to others when explaining the success he has experienced over the years. He doesn't "*strut his stuff*" like some over paid performer demanding to be the center of attention on the world's stage. Peyton and his wife Ashley have given such generous contributions to St. Vincent's Hospital in Indianapolis that it was renamed in his honor in 2007. They never sought the honor. When Hurricane Katrina devastated New Orleans, Peyton was on the scene working with Drew Brees to aide in the relief effort for the people of the city. Unlike others, he has never self-destructed because he has never been self-absorbed. With the boorish and irresponsible behavior of so many professional athletes flooding the airwaves, Peyton, and many others like him, simply live their lives with a quiet dignity like a son who has grown into a man ought to do.

You may not be a fan of football and wouldn't waste your time with the game-of-games regardless of when it came on the TV. That's perfectly OK. The last time I read my Bible it didn't mention anything about the Super Bowl or football. But it does have a lot to say about how we live our lives. None of us have the money or the fame of the Peyton Manning's of this world. But within our limited circle of family and friends we all have influence. The lives of all of us are telling a story. Our words and our behaviors are making powerful statements about who we are and what we value. We are Christians. We serve the Lord Jesus. Let's be sure that our "*speech is always with grace, seasoned with salt, so that we may respond properly to those who come our way.*" None of us will ever play in a Super Bowl. Few, if any, of us will probably ever attend one. (A good seat will run you about \$28,000 a ticket.) But the life we are living is no game. It's very real....and at times it is extremely challenging. The way we live it...and the way we confront the challenges of it...will impact more people than we often realize. So...."*Whatsoever you do, do all to the glory of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.*"
