THE DEBATE CONTINUES

I received my latest issue of the National Geographic last week. While not always agreeing with everything written therein I always enjoy the reading. The section that most drew my attention in this edition is the section dealing with "black holes." I am not even a fourth cousin twice removed from a physicist, but these things are truly amazing. Only God knows everything about this things, but what is known by us is astounding. If you want to sit in awe of the wonders of God's creation this is a pretty good place to sit. If you want to get lost in the consideration of the power and might of the God who loves us then looking into these black holes is certainly awe-inspiring. They remind me of God. No one has seen God. And no one has seen or ever will see a black hole. Yet all of science acknowledges the reality of this un-seeable hole. The evidence is too overwhelming to deny. These are dead stars that have collapsed upon themselves. Their gravitational pull is so great not even light can escape...so they simply cannot be seen. The gravity is so powerful that if Mt. Everest were made of solid iron and were pulled into a black hole it would be reduced in size to a grain of sand. If our planet were pulled into the thing it would be reduced to size of a human eye. The bottom of the black hole is called a "singularity." It is extremely heavy and extremely small. If you could magnify it a trillion trillion times it still would not be visible under our most powerful microscope. What exactly is in this singularity that is so small yet indescribably heavy? Science says we will never know. They are simply impenetrable. Our universe is full of black holes. They grow in size and power until they become so heavy and volatile that they explode sending future suns and planets hurling across the universe.

I just cannot understand how any scientist can devote a life to the study of such things yet say that there is no God. In all of the investigation that science has done on the origins of our universe they simply cannot bring themselves to truly contemplate the true "First Cause." There are questions that science will never be adequate to answer until science acknowledges the reality of the "Who" that was present before the beginning. The power that science seems to worship that is evident in such things as black holes...that power exists because the all powerful One spoke into the darkness in the beginning and said "Let there be light." God and science...reason and faith...divine creation and cosmic expansion are not mutually exclusive. The raw facts of science will never be adequate to answer the deepest questions of the human heart. Only the God whose image we bear can provide the answers that we so desperately seek. We remember the words of David as he contemplated these things. "I look up at your macro-skies, dark and enormous, your handmade sky jewelry, moon and stars mounted in their settings. Then I look at my micro-self and wonder, Why do you bother with us? Why take a second look our way? Yet we've so narrowly missed being gods, bright with Eden's dawn light. You put us in charge of your handcrafted world, repeated to us your Genesis charge, made us lords of sheep and cattle, even animals out in the wild, birds flying and fish swimming, whales singing in the ocean deeps. God, brilliant Lord, your name echoes around the world." **Psalm 8:3-9** MV Well...I suppose humanity will debate all of this stuff until Jesus comes again. Do your own study. Use the intelligence that God our Creator has given. Remember..."The Heavens declare the Glory of God."
