During a harsh winter they dig ugly holes in the middle of smooth streets to rattle our teeth and ruin our suspension. Guys like me are constantly reminding good folks like you that *"life is a journey."* We sit down and map out our journey to success and happiness. We want to move in a straight line to the goal of success with no detours, construction zones, or ugly potholes. We want wide, smooth roads to carry us along in this journey of life. We quite often do not get what we want. So...just how is your journey going? Roy Rogers and Dale Evans always ended their 1950's cowboy show singing *"Happy Trails to You."* I loved their show when I was a little cowpoke....and I still do. But....truth be told....the trails we travel are often anything but happy. There are no roads without potholes. Rough, steep, and slow are often better descriptors of the road we travel than smooth, straight, and comfortable. Yes, a lot of life is simply not under your control. Sometimes the only thing you can control is your attitude toward those things which you cannot control. Attitude always involves conscious choice. Making our life's journey over a road filled with potholes and detours would probably not be our first road of choice. But it may be our only option.
