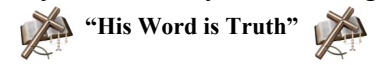


THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT

What is it? Most of us could probably pull out of our crowded memory most of the ten commandments if we were pressed to do so. We might miss one or two, and we might not get them in the correct order as listed in Exodus, but Christians are certainly familiar with them. Most Americans are familiar with them if for no other reason than that they crop up on a media broadcast from time-to-time when some conservative religious group is insisting that they be on public display in a courthouse or public school somewhere. Of those ten commandments eight are a prohibition. God gave the children of Israel eight things that they were absolutely forbidden to do. Those things ranged from the making of idols for worship to coveting that which belongs to your neighbor. Only two of those ten are things that we must do rather than things we must refrain from doing. One of those two things we must do is to honor our fathers and mothers. The other of those two things is the fourth commandment: *“Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy.”* **Exodus 20:11** And God goes on to explain that on that seventh day they were to *“do no work.”* He didn’t tell them in particular what they were to do on that day, but He told them exactly what they were not to do. I like the comment one scholar made regarding the Sabbath when he said that: *“Sabbath keeping was a publically enacted sign that the Jewish people trusted God to keep the world running, therefore they could step away from that responsibility on that day.”* The Jewish people could know that they could leave their plows in the field, their shops closed, their journeys halted in the confidence that the world would not stop turning because they weren’t there. Sabbath was the day that Jewish people were to put the world in its place. It was how they took over the world’s time and made it into God’s time.

You know your Bible. You know that old covenant was nailed to His cross...taken out of the way...replaced by a new one dedicated by the blood He shed for our sins. Most of those who insist we are to keep the ten commandments wouldn’t like it if we did. Planes wouldn’t fly, hospitals would be closed, gas stations shut down, and no more football on that holy day. We are not under the Sabbath law. But...you knew that was coming, didn’t you? Sunday is a holy time to most of us. If we view any day as a day of rest in our hectic and crazy time it would be the Lord’s day. There are many ways in which we “put the world in its place,” and showing up here for worship is one of those ways. While certainly not agreeing with Martin Luther on many of his views I do agree with his statement, *“The purpose of the Sabbath is not merely that we stop work....but that we give God the time to work in us.”* None of us are of Abraham’s lineage...we are not Jews...yet Paul’s statement is true: *“For he is not a Jew which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh. But he is a Jew which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.”* **Romans 2:28-29** We have to be careful when it comes to this world, don’t we? *“All that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, the pride of life is not of the Father, but of the world,”* were the words of John in **I John 2:15**. Use every opportunity to step away from this world and it’s work in order to let God continue His work in you. Thank you for being here this morning....and thank God for giving us this opportunity.
