WHAT MATTERS MOST

Boy, we have a lot of stuff, don't we? Where did it all come from? When Donna and I moved from Fayetteville to Ft. Smith for my practice teaching at Ramsey we put everything we owned in a small Ford Falcon and the back of a pick up truck with room to spare. In almost a half century of marriage our "stuff" overflows a house, garage, and attic. And I can assure you we are not hoarders. We've frequently "cleaned out and thrown away" over the years. Several months back I decided to "do something" about our attic. When we built the house I got up in the rafters before sheetrock was installed and carried up enough plywood to put a floor down for future storage. As the years passed by the attic became a dumping ground for anything we were hesitant to throw away. Garbage bags full of treasures and cardboard boxes full of who-knows-what were piled to the ceiling. The heat in the attic caused the bags to fall apart. It was a mess. So...several trips to Yeager's provided enough plastic bins to properly store the stuff and label it on the outside. What we didn't haul to the dump was now neatly labeled and stacked. It's just sitting up there over our heads accumulating dust...waiting for someone to do something with it. The next time most of those bins will be opened will be after Donna and I are through with this world. The kids and grandkids will be left with the task of deciding what to do with the left overs of two lives that have gone on to another world where the contents of an old attic have absolutely no value or use.

How do you decide what to keep...or what to throw away? If you are awakened in the dead of night with smoke detectors screeching in your ear what is it that you try to save first? Family, certainly. Family pets next...but then what? Are you going to risk your life trying to pull a sixty inch flat screen off the wall? Probably not. You will go for that box where the truly valuable things are kept. Pictures...spanning the lifetime of a wonderful marriage. Pictures and mementos of children now grown and grandchildren nearly so. Cards containing handwritten messages from the someones that truly mattered in your life. A piece of old jewelry that belonged to a previous generation in your family. Chances are pretty good that what you will be grabbing holds very little value to anyone other than you. Just try to auction the contents of that box off on E-Bay or take it to the closest pawn shop. You will soon learn that one mans treasure is another mans trash. Life ultimately reduces our treasure to those things that remind us of people that we love, and people that love us. We sing an old song from time-to-time...the primary message is intended to teach us what we sing when we sing *"Earth holds no treasure but perish with using...however precious they be."* The true treasures of life cannot be stored away in a box somewhere. The only vessel suitable for such storage is the human heart. A heart that has been shaped and molded by the love of God. Jesus reminded us to *"not hoard treasure down here where it gets eaten by moths and corroded by rust or...worse...stolen by thieves. Stockpile treasure in heaven where it's safe from moth, rust, and burglars. It's obvious, isn't it? The place where your treasure is, is the place you will most want to be....and the place you will end of being."* **Matt. 6:19-21my**
