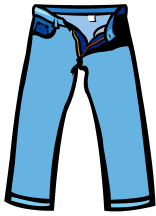

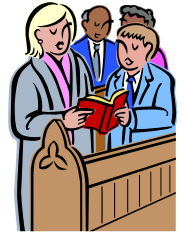

**"LITTLE DUCKS"....**Have you ever heard of their prayer? If not, it goes like this: *"Dear God...Give us a flood of water...Let it rain tomorrow and always...Give us plenty of little slugs...and other luscious things to eat...Protect all folks who quack...and everyone who knows how to swim...Amen.* What the ducks pray for the farmers fear. So long as one chooses to swim only in a little pond, the fresh-water delights of stream, river, and ocean are simply unreal. The tendency of most folks is to live with a fairly narrow perspective of life. We know life as it is here in this Church and in the area surrounding Dayton. We're comfortable with that life and sometimes a little apprehensive about the circumstances of other folks in other places. (and sometimes downright suspicious of them) We seem strange to New Yorkers, and New Yorkers seem strange to us. But, bottom line, we're all just people. The made-in-the-image of God kind of people. When God commanded that we *"love our neighbor as ourselves"* He didn't mean for that to be restricted to the geographic lines of Sebastian County. Jesus loved people. All kinds of people. People whose lifestyles others approved of, and people who were shunned by those around them. He had this amazing capacity for looking beyond the circumstances of a person's life and truly seeing the person. May God help all of us to grow in that capacity. You remember that Isaiah wrote of Him..... *"He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall He not quench: He shall bring forth judgment unto truth."* **Isaiah 42:2-3** Jesus would endure the smoking flax even though no one wants smoke up their nose and in their eyes. He would endure that for the sake of the person He loved. May God give us eyes to see what we should be seeing. Larry B
