TAKING FAITH SERIOUSLY

Do we? I'm not just talking about folks here at Dayton, but folks in general scattered all over this wonderful nation. Faith is thought to be a serious subject, but just how seriously do folks really take it? And I mean faith in general. How about satanists? They are certainly people of faith. They just believe that the devil has the answers and the real power, not God. I've not known many folks who worship the devil. I would occasionally bump into one at school. It would be some kid who was "daring to be different." Invariably it was one who didn't participate in band, choir, athletics, or any other activity that bonded him with other students. He wasn't a very good scholar. He was ignored at home, at school, and elsewhere. This made him stand apart. It at least got other folks talking about him...got him noticed. In dress, conversation, and attitude he seemed serious. But behind closed doors, when it was just him and me, he was just a kid desperately needing attention. His faith in satan didn't last beyond the public eye. It was just a show put on for the benefit of others...staged in order to create an image. USA today interviewed a spokesman for satanism seeking a response to the evil things done in the name of the devil. His response: *"We satanists are just creative people who are experimenting with individuality and self-awareness, but we don't really take all that "evil" stuff seriously. " Most satanists claim that they are not really such bad apples...not really that different from anyone else. "We tend to defy authority, take what we want, do as we choose, and get even with folks who wrong us, but we talk a lot better game than we live. Folks shouldn't really expect us to live out our tough talk. Truth be told, most of us don't even believe in the devil. Try not to take us too seriously."*

Really??? Is that the way it is for most folks of faith....whether the object of our faith is God or the devil? Could there be people who profess their faith in God in order to create an image? They select a church and show up from time-to-time. They mix and mingle with other folks of faith and give lip service to the things that other folks seem to believe, but their faith never goes beyond the public image they are seeking to create. There's nothing stirring in their soul....no passion....no fire....no commitment....no life changing convictions that reach into every relationship and mold every decision. They walk through this world on the fringe of faith insisting by the life they live that we *"not take them too seriously."*

Could that be me? Certainly. Just how serious am I about this faith that I profess? My Bible says that I am to *"walk by faith."* Is that descriptive of my walk? While admonished in Scripture to *"walk in the light"* do I prefer the shadow? If I want others to take me seriously then I must be serious about my faith. *"Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word which is able to save your souls. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.....But who looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed."* **James 2:21f** We confess Christ. It is not unreasonable for people to expect us to "take Him seriously." Our life is different in fact...and in function because of our faith.
