"THOSE LITTLE THINGS".... They really do matter, don't they? We've been told that over and over by folks who seem to know what they're talking about. Maybe I should learn to listen to them a little better. Big things are big. They grab our attention. They win the applause. They make the headlines. Who wouldn't be interested in doing those? Little things go unnoticed. They tend to be so small they seldom bring any recognition. Scott Scarborough is the new president of the University of Akron. At one of his first meetings of his administrative team he asked for some commitments from them. In the list of things required were the usual things such as collegiality, teamwork, ethical conduct, respect for the diverse nature of the university, support of team decisions, etc. All of those kind of things are what you expect to hear in those kind of meetings. Here's the ones that were not so expected....pick up the trash around you....be on time....always do what you say you are going to do....answer questions simply and directly....be where you are supposed to be, doing what you are supposed to be doing....don't be unkind in your conversations about others on your team. None of those things are going to win a plaque, but all of them, little though they are, work together to bring success. So....we remind each other in our Christian journey to *"take care of the little things."* We've all noticed that folks who tend to be sloppy in the little things are sloppy in the big ones as well. People who gossip about others in your presence will gossip about you in your absence. Our Lord was not silent on the subject of these little things. *"If you are faithful in little things, you will be faithful in the big ones.
