Larry Bridges will be preaching this morning. **Dustin Dacus** will be doing the preaching for us this evening.

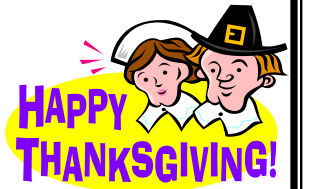
Our next monthly elders, deacons, and men's **business meeting** will be held this evening beginning at 5:00 downstairs. Men, we encourage your presence.

WHAT LIES AHEAD

I don't know much about the future. What little I do know I know because the Bible speaks of a future time and what that time might look like. I'm no prophet. Like all of you, I can predict things....but a prediction is just that. There's no certainty in it. I do, however, know this one thing about the future with absolute certainty. Change is coming. I know it's coming because it always has come. Nothing stays the same here in this world other than the action of God in our behalf. The Bible story centers around Moses. He delivers the Children of Israel from Egyptian bondage. That 40 year pilgrimage from Egypt to the promised land has long served as a metaphor for all of life for all of us. We're all caught up in the story. We're all on a journey, and as I've told you before it, is in the very nature of journeying that things do not stay the same.

I like routine...maybe I like it too much. But probably most of us prefer life with minimal change. We don't like to be disturbed so we carve out our routines. We like predictability. We feather our nests and want them to stay feathered. We talk to each other about the "good old days." Many of us are no longer the spry, energetic, go-getters that we once were, and we yearn for the old days....but not too much. We don't prefer life before anti-biotics, power steering, air conditioning, television, and coronary bypass surgery. We want to take the blessings of a changed today and somehow wrap them up in the past. It can't be done. Change is inevitable...for all of us. We receive an unwelcome diagnosis from the doctor. We are forced to change jobs after many years of comfortable employment. A long held dream slips beyond our reach. We lose a loved one. We develop pains in places in our body that we didn't even know we had. Things change.

So....what do we do with the reality of change. We accept it. We do what God challenges us to do.... "Believe in Him." We face the inevitable change with faith in God. We believe that He is already present in all the places that are new and untested to us. When Moses and the children of Israel finally arrived at the promised land they discovered that God was already there waiting on them. Wherever it is that life is leading you, please believe that God is already present in those places. He is as much present in our changed tomorrow as He was in our previous past. Yes, change can sometimes be a little frightening, but remember what God tells us. "Be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave you, nor forsake you. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I WILL NOT FEAR...." **Hebrews 13:5-6**
