ASSEMBLY CHANGES DUE TO CORONAVIRUS

- ◆ We will assemble on Sunday morning at 10:00 for worship.
- ◆ There will be no Sunday or Wednesday evening worship.
- ◆ There will be no Bible classes held.
- ◆ We will not be providing child care during the worship assembly.
- ◆ No end-of-the-month fellowship meals will be served.
- ◆ We will avoid all handshaking and hugging. This will be a challenge for our friendly church.
- ◆ Be aware of spacing during the worship service. Six feet is recommended.
- ◆ We need to leave every other row empty for spacing and for the servers to walk across during communion.
- ◆ Families may certainly continue to sit together.
- ◆ We encourage older members with weakened immune systems to remain home until it is deemed safe for you to return. If you are running a fever you should remain at home.
- ◆ MASKS AND GLOVES ARE OPTIONAL.
- ◆ Make every effort to maintain proper distancing while visiting before and after services.
- ◆ Hand sanitizers will be available in the restrooms and on the tables in the foyer for your use. We will provide this as long as they are available.
- ◆ Ionizers will be used to sanitize the auditorium prior to its use on Sunday morning.
- ◆ These changes will be reviewed regularly to determine if they need to be revised.
- ◆ We will continue to communicate through e-mail and Facebook regarding any further changes. If your e-mail address has changed or if you are not receiving my weekly e-mails please provide me with a correct address.

In the communion service we will be using three servers rather than six. You will not be asked to touch or pass the plates in any way. Those will stay in the hands of the servers. You will find that the bread is now in individual cups like the fruit juice. Simply take a cup when the server presents it. **We ask that you keep both the bread cup and juice cup and not replace it in the plate. When the servers present the contribution plate they will also be carrying a small basket where we ask that you deposit the used cups. By doing so we lessen the risk of you touching anything that has been touched by someone else.**

These changes are not made out of fear. *“God has not given us the spirit of fear, but of power, of love, and of a sound mind,”* as Paul told Timothy. The changes are being made out of compassion for others who may be more vulnerable than we are. Let’s take care of each other just as God takes care of us.
