**A FRIEND LIKE NO OTHER**

I consider myself blessed to count a number of great folks as my friends. Some I've known for my entire lifetime, some only for a short time. Some know me quite well, and others just on the surface. I try to be (and typically am) a pretty friendly guy. For example, most of the time we use that Grocery Pickup option at Wal-Mart - but occasionally we'll have to go in for something we forgot or didn't get enough of. There's just not a quick in-and-out - we always run into someone, or in some cases several folks, that we know and we get to visiting for awhile. Laura and Harry can tell you when (not if) we run into somebody, we're going to be there awhile. It's a good problem to have.

Regardless of how long some of my friends have known me, how well they know me, or how often we talk - they can't compare to God. **Psalm 139** is a passage that I read frequently and think about regularly. It starts right off talking about how the Lord knows us - and it's clear that He knows us even better than we know ourselves. **"You have searched me, Lord, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you, Lord, know it completely. You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.** The thought of someone knowing us in such great detail can be terrifying - or it can be comforting. I prefer to think the latter. It's encouraging to me to think that before I speak a word, before I even come up with a single thought - God is there. God has searched me. Regardless of whether or not I am thinking of Him in that moment, regardless of whether or not I have called for Him - He's never left me. Despite all of the things that I do wrong day in and day out, He is forever there and promises that He will continue to be. He's constantly searching the deepest parts of my heart. Most days, I'd like to think this heart goes down the right path. I try to think, say, and do the right things that God wants. But you know what? Some days, I takes the wrong fork in the road. Even then, God still wants to be right here.

In this life, we make friends and sometimes we even lose friends. That's just the nature of this human heart and this world. Even with the greatest of friends, none can come even close to comparing to God. When I look back at my past I can see Him there, guiding me along, never leaving me for even a moment. When I look to the future, I don't see exactly what's planned or exactly what's going to happen - but I see Him there. I know in my heart that He always will be. We never have to worry about Him leaving us, because He has promised us He won't.
