"PSALM 46:10"

That's a famous verse even though you might not be able to quote it without a hint or two..."*Be still and*"...you can finish the verse from there, can't you? If you are still struggling let me finish it for you..."*know that I am God.*" That's not always as easy as it sounds, is it? As old as that verse is, it's still pretty good advice for both then and now. The only problem is just where do you find (or make) the time to do that? Families just being families in 2022 struggle to find calm amid the chaos. Wonderful things can happen in times of solitude, stillness, and silence before God. Regardless of how much we love those times, "stillness" is simply not to be had on some days and in certain life experiences. Supporting your family makes certain demands upon your life. There are places where you simply have to be, and things you simply have to be doing in order to keep the wolf away from the door. Yes, you could set your alarm an hour earlier, but when your normal day begins at 5:00 a.m. and ends when the sun goes down (or after) the night can grow so short you endanger your health. And the chaos isn't just due to a hectic work schedule. Sadness, disappointment, and loss crash over us like the roaring of an angry sea. Pain from illness, injury, or an aging body scream at you demanding your attention.

Let's just face it. We live in a noisy world, and we have busy lives. I think maybe the challenge for most of us today isn't in finding "stillness", but in learning how to hear God's voice smack in the middle of all the noise and confusion that so often surround us. Do any of us really think that ours is the first generation of folks to experience the pressure of noise, tension, and uncertainty? Definitely not. Can we hear from David again? "*They reeled and staggered like drunken men: they were at their wits' end. Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and He brought them out of their distress. He stilled the storm to a whisper: the waves of the sea were hushed. They were glad when it grew calm, and He guided them to their desired Haven.*" **Psalm 107:27-31** I don't know who these guys in Psalm 107 were, but I know this. They were reeling and staggering under their load. There was no serene stillness before God for them. Life had become overwhelming. They were exhausted just from living it. But...in the middle of the frenzy and distress they "cried out to the Lord in their trouble", and He heard them. If your life has been more tumult than stillness, more crash than calm, God is certainly aware of your circumstances. You can still cry out to Him, and when you do, He will certainly show Himself to you. Be sure to look for Him. In the midst of the noise and chaos, His presence will surround you with peace.
