"MY JESUS, I LOVE THEE"

"My Jesus, I love thee. I know thou art mine." That sounds familiar, doesn't it? Those are the words we speak to our Lord every time we sing that song. Martin Luther wrote of the young people of his day in the 16th century that, *"They are utterly dissolute and disorderly."* Many years before Plato had written, *"The youth are rebellious, pleasure-seeking, and irresponsible. They have no respect for their elders."* About the same time Socrates was complaining that *"Children now love luxury. They have bad manners, contempt for authority, and disrespect for their elders. They love only to chatter."* Inscribed on a 6,000 year old tomb in Egypt were these words. *"We live in a decadent age. Young people no longer respect their parents. They are rude and impatient. They inhabit taverns and have no self control."*

Has there ever been a generation when the older folks did not think the younger generation was losing it...going from bad to worse? Probably not. But young folks eventually grow up to become the very generation that would next jump on the bandwagon regarding just how bad young folks are. We should all remember that God has always had teenagers who were ready to face tremendous challenges while remaining faithful to Him. Everyone reading this knows the story of Joseph...of David...of Daniel and others whose faith held firm despite being young of age. Some of the greatest songs that we sing here at Dayton on a regular basis were written by teenagers. The song mentioned above was written by William R. Featherson when he was sixteen years old. William was born July 23, 1846, in Montreal. He died in the same city twenty-six years later at the age of forty-two. William wrote the poem in celebration of his conversion to our Lord. Little else is known about the author, but that's okay. It is enough to remind all of us older folks that we have no monopoly on faith, and that the young have much to offer when it comes to honoring our Father. We have some remarkable young people right here at Dayton. They have big hearts, and a determination to "do the right thing." We just graduated three teens who are an example of all that is right among our young people today. Over the years we have seen so many of our young ones grow up, and move on to other places away from family and home church. But not all that leave Dayton leave the Lord. They take their faith with them when they leave. They carry the Bibles we give them from one home to the next, and as they do they carry the name of Christ to new locations among new people. That sixteen year old William continues to share his words and his faith in the songs that he has written. This song reminds us all of what John wrote....*"We love Him because He first loved us."* **I John 4:19**
