YE WHICH ARE SPIRITUAL

You remember Paul's challenge, don't you? Here it is. "Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness considering thyself lest thou also be tempted." **Galatians 6:1** But...just who are those folks? This is America. We enjoy all kinds of freedoms. Among those is the freedom to create some incredibly strange notions of spirituality and spiritual life. So...we end up thinking the spiritual guy is the one squatting on a mountain top waiting for the world to come to him for answers. He's the guy with the backward collar and multiple degrees in theology. He's the guy with the shaved head and the saffron robe that begs for a living. Go to any large city and you'll find spiritualists in the yellow pages. They have some back alley shop with weird decorations and some lady in a weird costume that will give you answers if you pay her price.

Just who is this spiritual guy or gal the world has such a hard time defining? Can you even find them anymore? Certainly you can...if you know where to look. Most of us associate spirituality with church folks, and well we should. You will certainly find spiritual folks worshipping God on Sunday and at other times in public assemblies. But where do these folks go on Monday? Do they just fade away until the next time for the church to assemble? You know better than that, don't you? They take their spirituality with them when they leave this place. You find them at home with their family, at their workplace, on the road to and from work, at Walmart standing in line to pay for groceries, sitting in a chair reading a book to a grandchild, checking on a sick friend, at the kitchen table paying the monthly bills, etc. Here's something you already know. Spirituality isn't confined to the things we do within the walls of this church building. Jesus wasn't more spiritual teaching in the synagogue on a Sabbath than He was working in the carpentry shop or sitting in a boat on the Sea of Galilee. We all need quiet times for Bible reading, prayer, and contemplation of our relationship with God. But our spirituality isn't confined to places and times like that. If we aren't careful we can mistakenly think that we can reduce spirituality to a kind of pious sentimentality that we put on display for others to see. We all thank God for getting us through the tough times in life, and well we should. But spirituality isn't as much thanking Him for getting us through those times as it is reflecting His presence during them. Real spirituality is so deeply embedded within us that it plays out in the everyday, common events of living life in God's world. So...where do you find a spiritual person? You find them in that lengthy traffic line trying to get their kids to school on time on a Monday morning. You find them in a doctor's office waiting patiently to see a doctor who is running an hour behind. You will certainly find them as Paul says working to restore others to the joy of the Lord. And as you find them doing all of these things you will find them always displaying a true "spirit of meekness."
